Primitive plants

250 million years ago, plants began to produce pollen and seeds for the first time, a development which enabled them to reproduce more effectively. These first seed-bearing plants, known as Gymnosperms, have survived to the present day and are now extremely numerous.

A plot located near the entrance to the garden plays host to this particular plant collection which, in addition to the famous *Ginkgo biloba*, is home to various different species of *Cycad*, *Encephalarto*, *Zamia*, *Dioon* and *Macrozamia*.
