ACCESS WITH DOGS TO THE BOTANICAL HISTORIAL GARDEN LA CONCEPCIÓN



CODE OF CONDUCT

1st. – Only dogs that are identified by microchip, vaccinated and dewormed can access the Garden.

2nd. – All dogs shall be on leash at all times while in the Garden.

3rd. – Handler is responsible, under penalty, for picking up and disposing of their dog's waste (bagged) in the waste bins located throughout the Garden.

4th. – Handlers are required to monitor and control their dogs at all times, avoiding the inconvenience that may be caused to other dogs or people. When a dog presents aggressive behavior, the handler is required to control it and leave the premises immediately.

5th. – Any staff member may request a dog owner to leave the premises if he considers that the dog's or handler's behavior is not consistent with the rules here-by established.

6th. – Handlers are responsible and liable for any injury or damage caused by their dogs to other dogs, people and/or the premises.

7th. – Dogs of breeds classified as potentially dangerous must be led by and adult and must be muzzled. Handlers must use a strong non-extensible leash and may be asked at any time, to present the mandatory municipal license and proof of having a civil liability insurance in force.

8th. – Guide dogs for the visually impaired shall be exempt in all cases to have their dogs muzzled.

9th. – It is prohibited:

a) To let dogs access children's playgrounds, lawns, gardens or flower beds planted. They should remain at all times on the roads and paths that cross the garden.

b) The bathing of dogs in ornamental fountains, ponds and the like, or to let them drink from drinking fountains for public consumption.

c) The access of dogs to the Stately Home, garden shop, the covered part of the bar or any other space or area that may be indicated.
